Tender documents are to be completed in black ink and in accordance with the conditions and rules contained in the bid documents. Tender documents shall be available at Magareng Local Municipality Offices, Magrieta Prinsloo Street, Warrenton, 8530 on the **17 February 2025** until the **28 February 2025 closing dates indicated in each respective bid** upon the payment of a non-refundable document fee of **R 1000 for the complete set of tender document** per tender during office hours from 08h00 – 12:00 on weekdays.

The completed Tender documents must be placed in the Tender Box, situated at the main reception area of Magareng Local Municipality, Magrieta Prinsloo Street, Warrenton, 8530, no later than the **28/02/2025 closing dates indicated in respective bid**.

Only tenderers that score above the minimum threshold of **70%** of the maximum points for Functionality will be considered for further evaluation. Magareng Local Municipality reserves the right not to accept the lowest bid or to award a contract to the bidder scoring the highest number of points.

Tenderers are required to submit a municipal account bearing the Tenderers Entity's name as proof of payment of municipal services which is not older than 3 month and must not be in arrears for more than 3 months at the tender closure date. If the tender amount is above R10m (incl VAT), the municipal account must not be older than 3 months and must not be in arrears for more than 30 days.

If the value of the tender amount is expected to exceed R 10 million (VAT included) and if the bidder is required by law to prepare annual financial statements for auditing purposes. The bidder must submit, their audited annual financial statements-

- for the past three years; or
- since their establishment if established during the past three years.

Telephonic, facsimile, email and/or late bids will not be accepted. Bids must be valid for a period of ninety (90) days after the closing date of the bid. The tenders will be evaluated in terms of the 80/20 preference points system of which 80 points will be for price and 20 points for specific goals as illustrated on MBD6.1

The Magareng Local Municipality does not bind itself to accept the lowest or any bid and the Municipality reserves the right to accept the whole or any part of any bid and further reserves the right to invite further bids if it so wishes to. No reasons for the acceptance or rejection of any bid will be given.
